Application Instructions

1. Eligible applicants include graduating high school seniors and students attending colleges located in Butte, Glenn, Tehama, Shasta, Siskiyou, Lassen, Plumas, Yuba, Colusa and Sutter Counties, or a student who is a child or grandchild of a member of our Chapter.

2. No handwritten applications will be accepted.

3. Applications must be received by **April 01, by 5:00 pm** and should be emailed or post-mailed to northvalleycwa@gmail.com.

4. All applications must include an unofficial transcript from applicant's high school or college.

5. All applicants must submit a resume highlighting school activities, awards and achievements, community involvement, and work experience.

6. All applications must include one current signed letter of recommendation. Letters may be submitted from a teacher, college professor, community member, employer, pastor, etc.

7. Preference will be given to first time applicants, applicants showing financial need, and applicants studying an agricultural or related field.

8. No late or incomplete applications will be accepted for consideration.

9. Please paperclip all post-mailed application materials.

10. Top recipients will be given the opportunity to interview with the scholarship committee.

11. Successful applicants will be required to submit official documentation signed by the school's registrar confirming enrollment. Scholarship funds will not be released until this documentation is submitted. **Awarded funds must be claimed within one academic year.**
